Preschool Program:

Preschool classes includes morning only class OR it can be combined with enrichment (extends day to 1:40 p.m.) Classes are offered 2, 3, 5 days per week. Enrichment highlights fine arts where children are exposed to famous artists, the orchestra, drama, and much more

Extended Day:

Extended day is an option for those who need care for the whole day from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Preschool for All:

This is a program funded by the Illinois State Board of Education. The main purpose is to give support to those who may need help developing in cognitive, social, and emotional skills essential for academic success in school. Please come visit the school if you think that this may pertain to you. Free to those who qualify.

Summer Camp:

Extended and 1/2 day is an option for those who need a fun-filled 10 week summer camp is offered each summer. Exciting visitors, field trips, and sprinkler days are among the events that take place throughout the summer.
